

League Registered Player Photos – Competition Sites

Leagues have an option to request that a photo of the player is attached to nominations for registration. Once approved, the photo cannot be changed without the approval of the league.

To enable the requirement for photo submission, go to Administration>Set Up>Registered Players>Player Photos tick the checkbox and Save the change.
