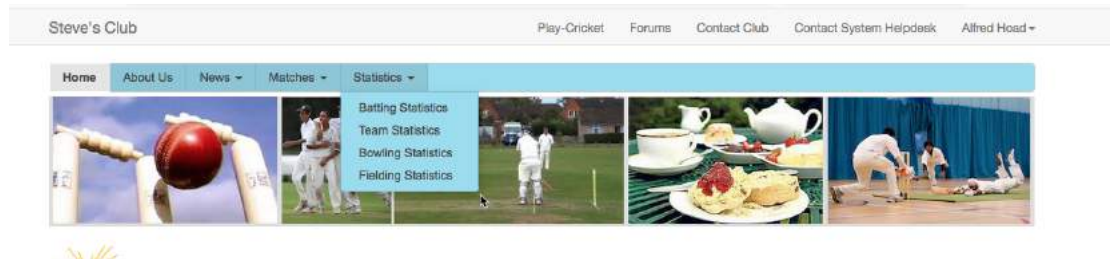


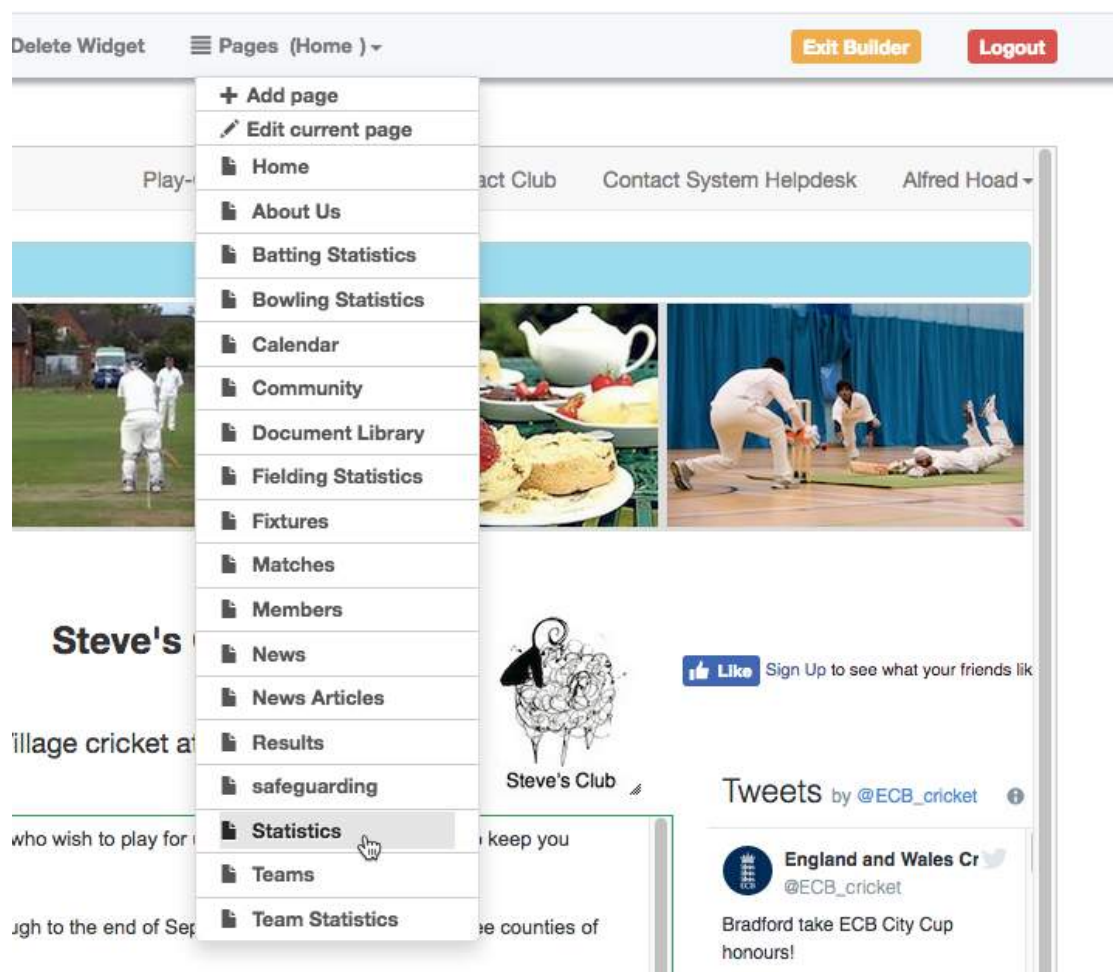
## Site Builder Sub-menu Links

The navigation bar that allows users to find different pages on your site has a limited number of slots available. Your pages can be organised into groups under headings of Junior Cricket, Teams etc.

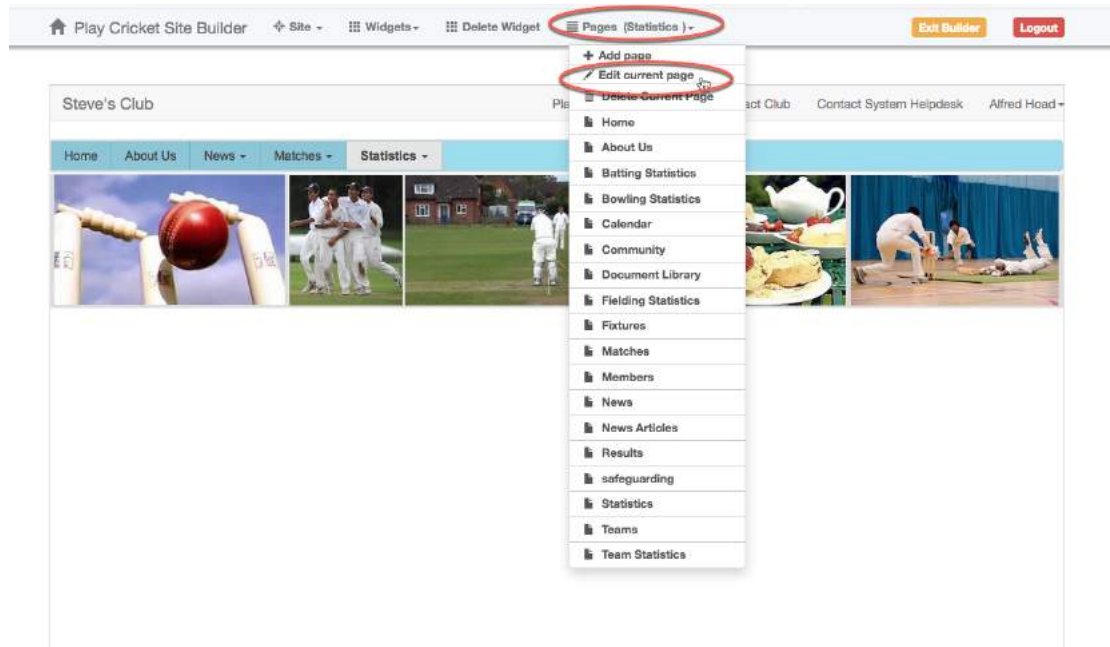
I will illustrate the process to create sub-menu links using the statistics pages. The screenshot below shows that the stats pages are grouped below a single item – 'Statistics'.



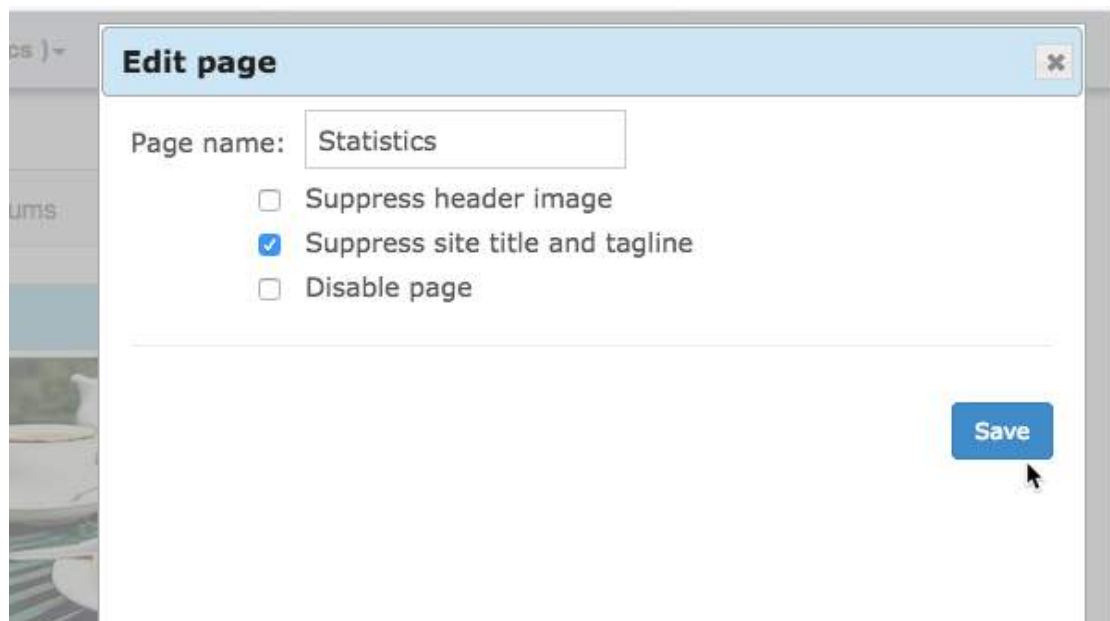
Go to Site Administration>Site Management>Site Builder and select the Statistics page.



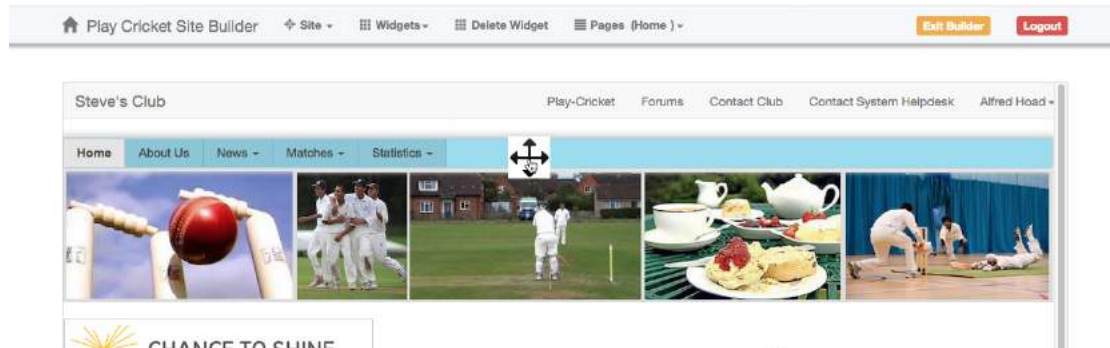
The Statistics page is just a blank holding page. but is not 'disabled' so that it appears on the navigation bar.  
To see the page settings, select Edit current page from the drop down list for Pages (Statistics).



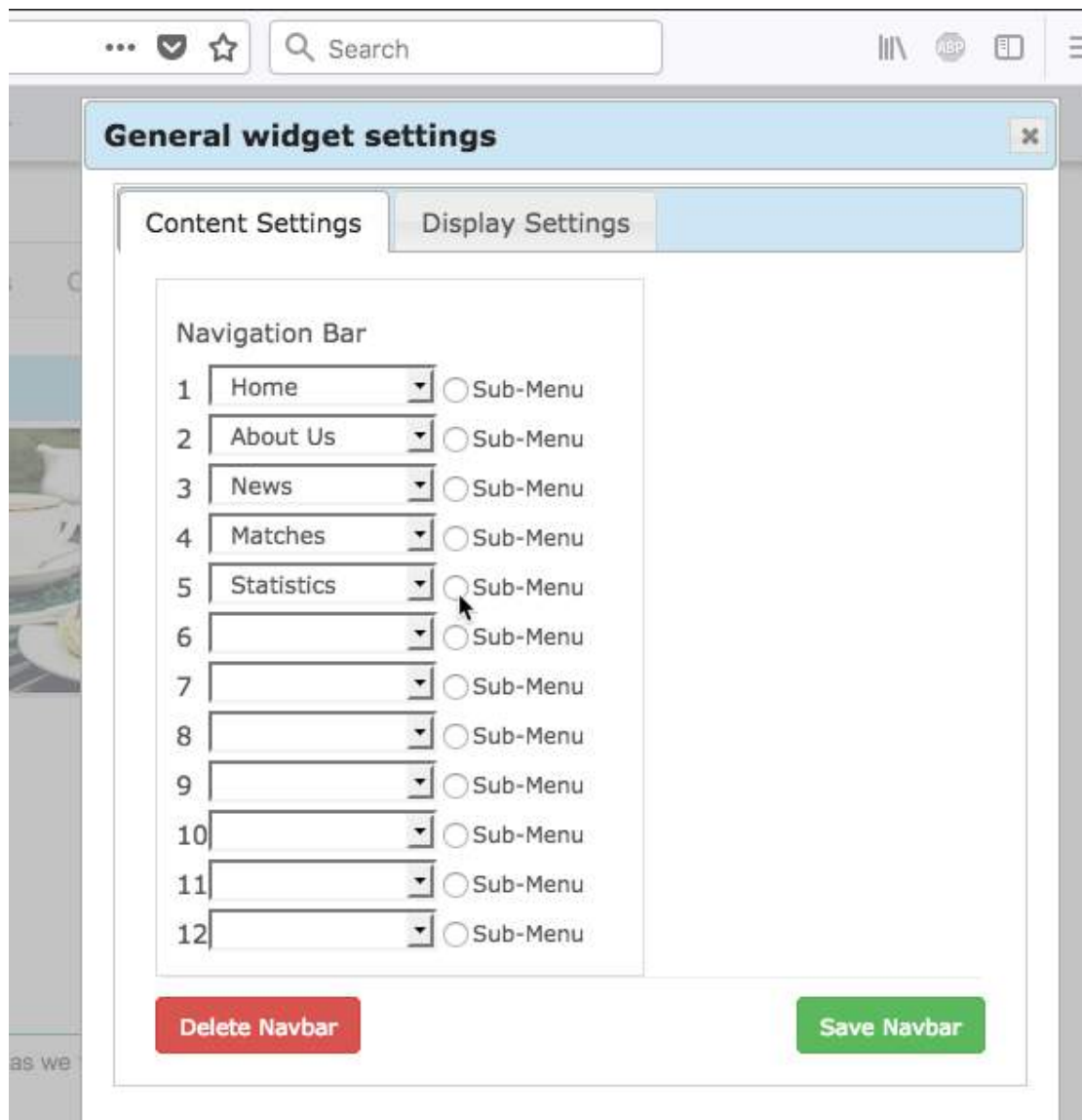
Note that the 'Disable page' setting is un-ticked so that the page name will appear on the navigation bar.



Close the Edit page pop-up window by clicking the cross in the top right corner.  
Now have a look at the navigation bar settings. Click on the bar to open the widget.



You will get the general widget settings for the 'navbar'.



Click on the radio button for the Statistics Sub-Menu to see the list of pages connected to the Statistics page.

Change the order of the pages by clicking on the item and selecting from the dropdown list.
